## Exclusions

1. Consumables, except when contaminated by warrantable failures

Generac

1. Cost of normal maintenance: tune-ups, associated parts, adjustments, loose/leaking clamps, installation and start-up
2. Starting batteries, fuses, light bulbs, engine fluids and any related labor

Briggs

1. Normal wear items include engine oil, oil gauges, o-rings, filters, fuses, spark plugs, anti-freeze, starting batteries etc.
2. Normal maintenance items such as adjustments, loose or leaking clamps or connections, installation or start-up operations, fuel system cleaning and obstruction due to contamination

Honeywell

1. Cost of normal maintenance: tune-ups, associated parts, adjustments, loose/leaking clamps, installation and start-up
2. Starting batteries, fuses, light bulbs, engine fluids and any related labor

Kohler

1. Engine coolant heaters, heater control, and circulating pumps after the first year
2. Starting batteries and labor and travel expenses related to battery services
3. Engine fluids such as fuel, oil, or coolant/antifreeze
4. Maintenance items such as fuses, lamps, filters, spark plugs, loose or leaking clamps, and adjustments
